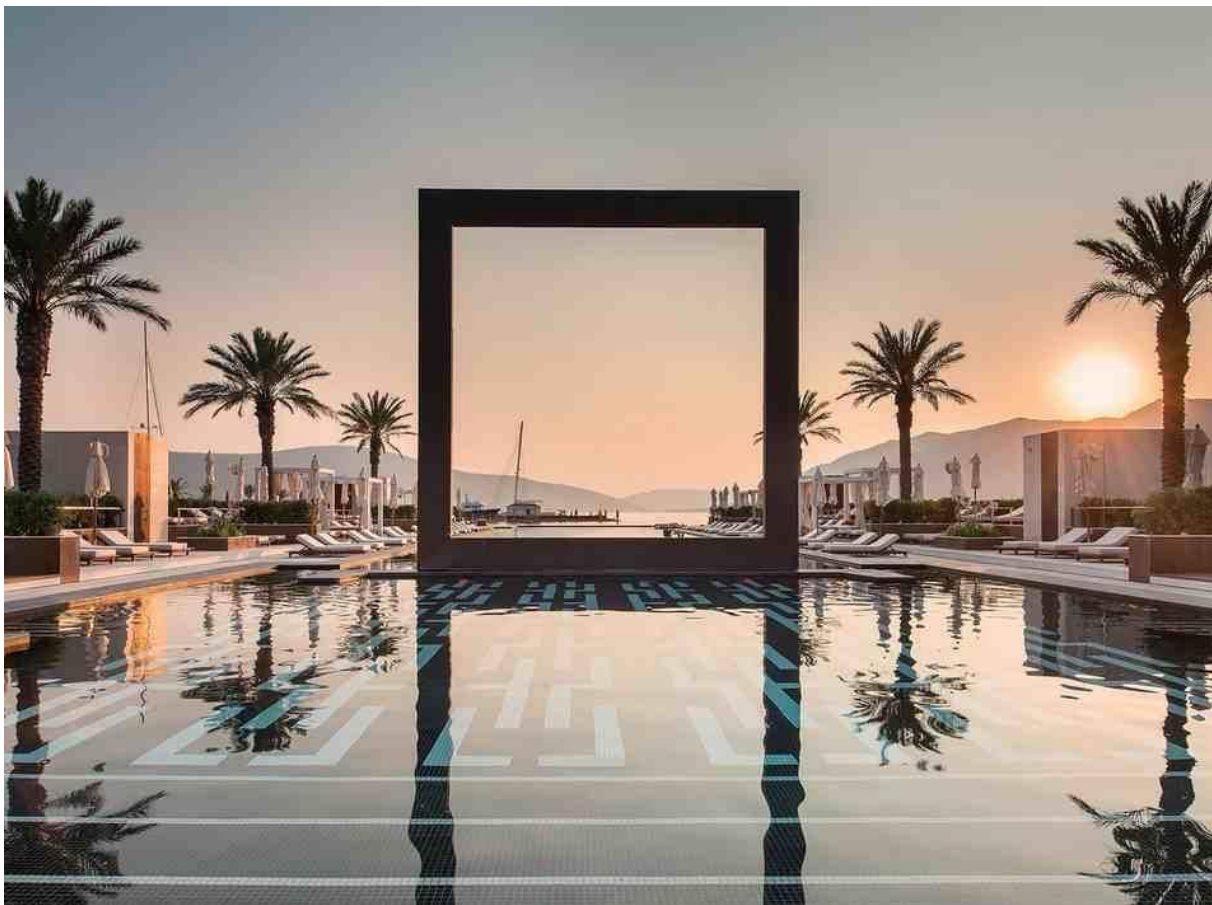

20 years MMIG46 is in itself a reason to celebrate, but this year's destination is all the more.

Our destination airports are Tivat **LYTV** and Dubrovnik **LDDU**.



Coming in to land at Tivat LYTV ... a bit too low ... and some sort of curious speed limit ...(?)...



but probably all the better to get a good view of the destination.

Here in *Porto Montenegro*, the 5* *Hotel Regent*, well known to viewers of the TV series *Traumhotels*, will be our home for a few days (behind the red and white crane).



Our welcome will take place in the afternoon / evening in the *Italian Garden* at the *Hotel Regent*!



Immerse yourself in the water themed *Aqua Wing* of the Hotel, on the way to the rooms or at the amazing Infinity-Pool-Landscape. Wellness in the true sense of the words!



We are on the coast of the UNESCO heritage site *Boka Bay* and will be discovering this and other special areas more closely.



The best way to do this is on a yacht, like this one here, exclusively chartered for our

group.



Perhaps we'll be leaving stones, like in the legend, on the island of *Our Lady of the Rocks* or ...



exploring the medieval town of *Kotor*, Venetian-style UNESCO World Heritage Site. The five miles long city walls, built between the 9th and 18th Centuries, surround this town like a giant triangle, rising up the slope to St John's Fortress.



But we wouldn't want to neglect the culinary delights, so we'll be stopping off at the “*Forza Mare*”. Here we are guaranteed a uniquely good lunch in a heavenly location.



Another excursion will take us to an olive plantation. The cultivation of olives and

the production of olive oil are typical for the rural life of Montenegro. At the same time, wine is produced here as well as ham from the animals kept here. Cheese is produced here too.



It is a poor, hard-working life.

But in spite or perhaps because of that a peasant family is proud to be able to offer us their produce while we take a break. But don't worry – this round outhouse is for the goats and not for our visit!



You can hardly believe your eyes – donkeys at the side of the road!



And historic looking fire engines are positioned all over the place to prevent disasters happening – and not just in the extremely dry 2018.



Back at the hotel in the afternoon there will be plenty of time to enjoy, for example, the fantastic pool area at the hotel or to explore Porto Montenegro for oneself.



As already mentioned, there will be many options, but we're not giving everything away just yet.

At Tivat Airport, the space available for parking our aircraft on asphalt is somewhat limited and only possible with prior permission. We would ask participants to appreciate that **allocation to the respective airport can only be done in consultation with the signatory.**

As Tivat Airport can only accommodate 8 aircraft, we would appreciate it if only

planes carrying at least 4 people were to land there. It would be most helpful if you could organize this among yourselves with your fellow aviators.

Those of our participants landing in Dubrovnik will be flown in just 20 minutes to Tivat on board a helicopter shuttle,

Helicopter flights will be provided both on the day of arrival (Thursday) and on the day of departure (Whit Monday). Departure times will be arranged after consultation.

The hotel rooms will be allocated in the same order as the registrations are received. That means the first to register will be allocated the best rooms.
